Hypericum spp. St. - Johns Wort¹

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Introduction




Figure 1. St. Johnswort.

This low growing plant can be used on dry sites (Fig. 1). The main ornamental trait is the three inch yellow flowers that contrast with the dark green foliage. The plant can grow a foot tall and can spread 1 1/2 feet. There may be some top kill in winter in cold climate.

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


Figure 2. Shaded area represents potential planting range.
