

MEMPHIS TITAN ROMEROI FROM VENEZUELA (LEPIDOPTERA: NYMPHALIDAE)

Memphis titan C. & R. Felder was described from Bogota, Colombia. The typical subspecies is known from numerous provinces in Colombia: Caldas, Boyaca, Cundinamarca, Antioquia, Vaupés, and from Ecuador: Río Pastaza and Río Topo. *Anaea titan peralta* Hall is the Central American subspecies, known from Panama (Chiriqui) and Costa Rica (Coronado, Cachi, Las Alturas).

The populations in the Cordillera de la Costa, in Venezuela, have been described recently as *Memphis titan romeroi* Descimon (1988), and this subspecies is here again illustrated.
